DAVID SEAMAN

David Seaman is widely regarded as one of the greatest goalkeepers in English football history, enjoying a hugely successful career at both club and international level. He was a key figure during Arsenal's dominant era under Arsène Wenger, making over 560 appearances for the club between 1990 and 2003 and playing a crucial role in multiple trophy-winning campaigns. Calm, reliable and an outstanding shot-stopper, David helped Arsenal secure three Premier League titles, four FA Cups, a League Cup and the European Cup Winners' Cup.

On the international stage, David earned 75 caps for England and represented his country at two World Cups and two European Championships. He was part of the England side that reached the semi-finals of Euro 96 and is fondly remembered for his crucial saves in penalty shootouts and big-match performances. Renowned for his consistency, composure and longevity at the highest level, he remains a hugely popular figure in football and a respected voice in the media.



PAUL GASCOIGNE

Paul Gascoigne, affectionately known as "Gazza", is one of the most naturally gifted and entertaining players ever to represent England. He earned 57 caps and scored 10 goals, playing a starring role in the nation's run to the semi-finals of the 1990 World Cup, where his emotional reaction to a yellow card became one of football's most iconic moments. He was also a standout performer at Euro 96, producing a moment of magic with his unforgettable goal against Scotland at Wembley.

At club level, Gazza rose to prominence with Newcastle United before becoming a fan favourite at Tottenham Hotspur, later enjoying successful spells with Lazio and Rangers, where he won league titles and domestic honours. Renowned for his flair, vision and larger-than-life personality, Gazza remains one of the most beloved and iconic figures in English football history.



STUART PEARCE

Stuart Pearce is one of English football's most iconic and uncompromising defenders, renowned for his passion, leadership, and fierce commitment on the pitch. Best known for his time at Nottingham Forest, where he made over 400 appearances between 1985 and 1997, Pearce became a club legend and earned the nickname "Psycho" for his fearless style of play. A powerful left-back with a thunderous shot, he was equally respected for his defensive resilience and ability from set pieces.

Stuart earned 78 caps for England, representing his country at multiple major tournaments including the 1990 World Cup and Euro 96. He famously exorcised his penalty demons with a memorable strike in the Euro 96 quarter-final shootout against Spain, celebrating with one of the most iconic moments in English football history. Following his playing career, he moved into coaching, including a spell as manager of Man City, where he was twice named Premier League Manager of the Month, as well as roles with the England U21s and the senior side. A natural leader with immense character, Stuart remains one of the most respected figures in the game.



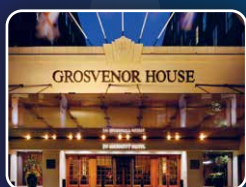
PETE GRAVES

Pete Graves is an award-winning TV Presenter, Events Host, Podcaster and Author. He is best known as a presenter on Sky Sports News and is also the face of Darts on ITV. Pete built a name for himself in Newcastle on local TV and Radio before being headhunted by Sky Sports in 2009. At Sky he has presented live football, rugby and hockey and is also the much loved host of 'Good Morning Sports Fans'. His podcast Transfer Talk was voted 'Best Sports Podcast' in 2023 and his book titled "Here To Compete", about the rise of his beloved Newcastle United, has sold more than 30,000 copies. In 2025 he was also named the lead presenter for Darts on ITV. Pete's energy, enthusiasm and sports knowledge makes him the perfect host for this event.
